**Marianne Geleijnse, Professor in Nutrition and Cardiovascular Disease**

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Johanna M. (Marianne) Geleijnse obtained a PhD degree in epidemiology at Erasmus University, Rotterdam, where she did research on salt and blood pressure. She currently holds a position as Professor in Nutrition and Cardiovascular Disease (tenured) at the Division of Human Nutrition and Health, Wageningen University. She is the Principal Investigator of the Alpha Omega Cohort of Dutch post-myocardial infarction patients ([www.alphaomegacohort.org](http://www.alphaomegacohort.org)). She is actively involved in the EU-H2020 funded SUSFANS project ([www.susfans.eu](http://www.susfans.eu)) and other multidisciplinary projects on sustainable and healthy nutrition. In 2018, she was appointed as Vice President of the Health Council of the Netherlands. She is a fellow of the American Heart Association and a member of the CHARGE/FORCE consortium (fatty acids research) and Global Burden of Diseases Platform. Marianne Geleijnse has supervised over 20 PhD students and (co-)authored around 300 publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals.
