

Androniki Naska

Androniki Naska is Associate Professor of Hygiene and Epidemiology at the School of Medicine of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA). She is a graduate of the Dept. of Chemistry of the NKUA School of Science; she has an MSc in Human Nutrition (King's College, University of London) and a Doctoral degree in Epidemiology (with distinction; School of Medicine, NKUA). Her research and scientific interests focus on nutritional epidemiology, including population surveillance, dietary assessment and diet-disease associations. As a faculty member, A. Naska participates in the teaching of epidemiology, research methodology, health promotion, prevention and public health to under- and post-graduate students of the University of Athens School of Medicine. A. Naska has additionally given lectures on epidemiology and nutritional epidemiology to post-graduate students of the Aalborg University (Copenhagen, Denmark), to the Dept. of Public Health and General Practice of the University of Kuopio (Finland), the School of Medicine of the University of Porto (Portugal) and to the Dept. of Biosciences at Novum of the Karolinska Institute (Stockholm, Sweden). A. Naska is Vice-Chair of the Dietetic Products, Nutrition and Allergies Panel of Experts of the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), Chair of the EFSA Working Group on Dietary Reference Values for minerals and Member of the WHO Collaborating Center for Nutrition and Health in the Department of Hygiene, Epidemiology and Medical Statistics.
