I was born in Salerno in 1962. I'm agronomist and food scientist.

I'm actually chair of the Division of Food Science and Technology and Full Professor of 'Agri-Food Industries', 'Mediterranean Diet Ingredients and Products' and 'Laboratory of Gastronomy' at the Department of Agricultural Sciences of the University of Naples Federico II (Portici, Naples, Italy).

I'm author of more than 280 publications on indexed journals, books and congress proceedings, covering many aspects of Food Science and Technology. My papers received more than 2,200 citations and I have an h-index of 28. The focus of my research is now on i) Food Lipids, Oxidation, Flavours and Antioxidants, ii) Olive Oil Quality and Technology, iii) 'Mediterranean molecular gastronomy'.

I'm well known at international level for the studies on food lipids by NMR spectroscopy, virgin olive oil nutritional and sensory quality, extraction technology and shelf-life as well as for my scientific-humoristic illustrations, my violin music within the 'Terraterra' agricultural folk band, and my dog Sofia, a 6 years-old Terranova.
